If you have taken equivalent(s) of Laurier courses at another university, you will receive a Laurier transfer credit for each such course. Your transfer credits will be added to the Laurier information system manually by humans at TransferCredit@wlu.ca and it will take time to process your transcript(s) and to obtain course equivalencies for your transfer credits.
