

## **'Directed Study' CP/PC395 /495 and 'Directed Research Project' CP/PC491-- 494 courses**

Only **Year-3** and **Year-4** students are eligible for CP/PC395.

Only **Year-4** students are eligible for CP/P495.

Only **Year-4 CS** and **DS** majors are eligible for CP493-494.

Only **Year-4 Physics** majors are eligible for PC491-492.

For all CP/PC395 /495 and CP/PC491-- 494 courses, students will have to find a [full-time faculty member](#), who is able and willing to supervise the course. It's a student responsibility to find/contact faculty member(s). After you have found the faculty member and (s)he is willing to supervise the course, do the following:

### **Additional Instructions for CP/PC395 and CP/PC495:**

For CP/PC395 and CP/PC495, **you must only use** the centralized FOS [Directed Study Request form](#). The Computer Science and Physics Undergraduate Advisor does neither accept, nor process requests for CP/PC395 and CP/PC495.

### **Additional Instructions for PC491-492 and CP493-494:**

For PC491-492 and CP493-494, you must ask the faculty member to email course syllabus **directly** to the Department Chair as well as copy to Physics and CS Adm. Assistant [pcs@wlu.ca](mailto:pcs@wlu.ca). Once the Department Chair has approved the course syllabus, you will need to request a course **override** via [pcs@wlu.ca](mailto:pcs@wlu.ca). Finally, after you have obtained the course **override**, you will be able to register on Loris. For further help with the process, contact [pcs@wlu.ca](mailto:pcs@wlu.ca).

**Note:** if a **PC491-492** or **CP493-494** course is not showing up in [Browse Classes](#) for a given term, then the course needs to be created by the Department Chair. So your prospective course instructor will need to **directly** ask the Department Chair to create the course for the given term. Once the Department Chair has created the course, it will show up in [Browse Classes](#) for the given term. For further help with the process, contact [pcs@wlu.ca](mailto:pcs@wlu.ca).

**Note:** CP493 is a prerequisite for CP494. Accordingly, CP494 may only be taken after CP493 has been completed. Similarly, PC491 is a prerequisite for PC492. Thus, you may take up to two 'Directed Research Project' courses in total.
