

GPA Requirements and GPA Calculation

1. [GPA Requirements for Progression and Graduation](#): Students have to maintain a minimum overall GPA of 5.00 and a minimum cumulative GPA of 5.00 in their honours major (i.e., Computer Science).

3. If converted to "CR", the course grade is excluded from student's GPA calculation. If deciding whether to convert your course grade to "CR", you can calculate your GPA with the ["CR" conversion](#) and without- and then decide. For help with "CR", contact ServiceLaurier@wlu.ca.
4. When a course is repeated, the grade received in the second [attempt](#) will be used to calculate the GPA, even if the grade in the second attempt is lower than in the first attempt. Note that the first attempt will remain on a student's transcript and will not be used for credit toward the program.
