

## Physics and Computer Science Classes: Online Vs In-person (on-Campus)

**Note:** 'Remote' was only available during Covid and no longer exists!

There are three class instructional modes: 'in-person', 'remote', and 'online'.

Each 'in-person' class has been assigned a room on campus.

Remote classes do not have rooms, but they do have scheduled class meeting time.

Online classes do not have scheduled class meeting times.

The following table summarizes the instructional mode details:
