

Vaccine Compliance and Online Courses Registration.

According to the university's COVID-19 mandatory vaccination policy, students, who have a Vaccine Compliance Hold, cannot be registered in- (and are de-registered from-) any in-person courses. Such students will be able to register in online courses, but only through the [Request to Add Online Courses with Vaccine Compliance Hold form](#). The requests will not be completed if you have any additional registration holds. For any questions related to COVID-19 Vaccine Compliance Hold, contact ServiceLaurier@wlu.ca.

To identify Laurier online courses, do the following: Open loris.wlu.ca/register > "**Browse Classes**" > **Select a Term** > Type in "Computer Science" or "Physics" > Scroll down to your course > 'Instructor/Meeting Times'. For example, see [screenshot-1](#) and [screenshot-2](#).

The following table summarizes the instructional mode details:

	In-person	Online

If both 'Meeting Time' and 'Room' are shown, then the course the instruction mode is 'in-Person'.

If both 'Meeting Time' and 'Room' are not shown, then the course the instruction mode is 'Online' as shown in this [screenshot](#).

While you might be able to take online courses at UW and other universities, it will be entirely your responsibility to identify such online courses at UW and other universities. Physics and Computer Science Advisor will unfortunately not be able to provide information on courses at UW and other universities. Note on Academic Progression: Irrespective of student's Vaccine Compliance Hold status, you might be able to switch to part-time or take up to two terms off, read [Minimum and Maximum Course Load](#).

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Tuition: If the course is successfully added, you are responsible for the online learning fee in addition to the tuition.

OSAP: If you are an OSAP student, we encourage you to notify the Student Awards Office (studentawards@wlu.ca) of your change in registration so they can amend your application.

Awards: Some scholarships and bursaries are dependent on specific course loads. Ensure you review the conditions of your award or applications.

Year Level: Year level is determined based on the number of courses completed. E.g. Year 1 0.00-4.50, Year 2 5.00 - 9.50, etc. Year level can impact: registration dates/time-ticket, RESP withdrawals, etc.
