

The Must-read for Year-1 CS, DS, and Physics majors

FOS (Faculty of Science) staff advisor(s) ScienceAdvising@wlu.ca is the initial point of contact for first year students of all majors and programs. They should contact Physics and Computer Science Advisor only if they are referred by a FOS advisor. So **you must contact** ScienceAdvising@wlu.ca.

Students must complete the mandatory online [Calculus Preparation Evaluation \(CPE\)](#) test before they will be able to register in [MA103](#) or [MA102](#). Based on the results of [CPE](#), a student may be required to complete MA102 before registering in MA103. If having questions or problems with MA102 or MA103 registration, contact Math advisor: mathadvising@wlu.ca.

Students registering in [PC131](#) must first register in a Calculus course (MA103 or MA102) before they will be able to register in PC131.
