

**Frequently Asked Questions:** "Will I be able to graduate and finish studies at the end of the Spring (or Fall or Winter) semester?" "Will I be able to graduate after I take three (or one or two) more courses?"

Physics and Computer Science Advisor will **not accept** inquiries involving timing, such as, "*whether or not you can complete certain courses within the next 6 (or 12) months*" and/or "*would I be able to graduate and finish studies at the end of the Fall/Winter/Spring semester*".

It's student's responsibility to plan their course schedule to satisfy the course requirements for their degree.

If students are unsure about the course requirements, they need to read and follow [Worksheet Instructions](#) and fill out the worksheet for their program before contacting the Advisor.

Similarly, Physics and Computer Science Advisor will **not accept** inquiries such as "*would I be able to graduate after I take three (or one or two) more courses*".

If you wish, you can fill out the worksheet and send to the Physics and Computer Science Advisor, so the Advisor would confirm whether or not the courses listed in your worksheet will satisfy the requirements for your degree. For co-op requirement's and co-op questions, you need to contact the co-op directly.

**To see courses offered in a given term:** Open [Browse Classes](#) > **Select a Term** > Type in "*Computer Science*" or "*Physics*" and scroll down.
